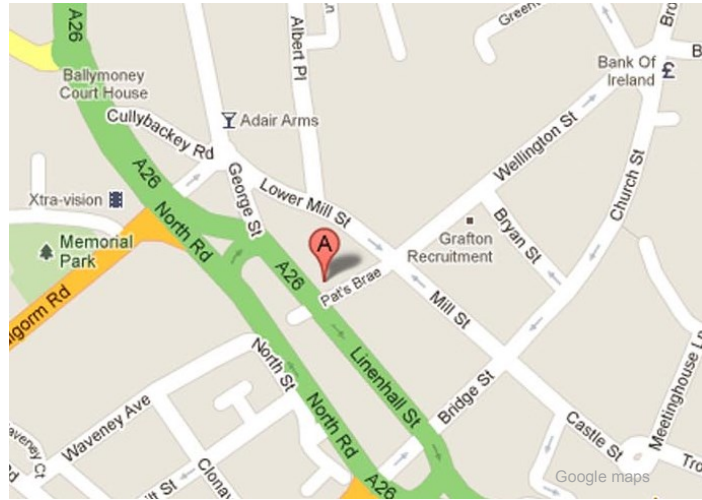

# Heritage Collection

## Ballymena Central Library



**THE HERITAGE COLLECTION** is on the first floor in Ballymena Central Library and covers all aspects of life in County Antrim and County Londonderry. It is a reference collection. Coleraine has a similar collection with emphasis on County Londonderry.

### Bookstock

Reference only and mainly non-fiction.

### Journals/Periodicals

Both academic and popular journals which are shelved alongside the book collection.

### Newspapers

National and local newspapers on microfilm.

### Maps

Ordnance Survey maps from 1830s-1970s, Griffith Valuation maps for County Antrim and County Londonderry, 19<sup>th</sup> Century town plans and Local Government maps.

### Photographs

Extensive collection for County Antrim and listed on library catalogue.

### Postcards

Collection illustrating the area and listed on library catalogue.

### Information packs

Arranged by location and subject and listed on library catalogue.

### Government Publications

Comprehensive selection of 19<sup>th</sup> Century government reports and current government publications.

### Archives

Collection of North Antrim poetry in Local Studies Ballymena. George Shiels Collection in Ballymoney library. Shiels (1881-1949) was a popular playwright born in Ballymoney. Coleraine library has an extensive Family History collection including the manuscripts and notebooks of Dr Hugh Mullin.
