This image is from the NI Direct website. On this website you will find information relating to benefits, health, motoring, pensions, citizens' rights, justice, education and much more.




Here are a few of the things you can do online:

The online form will look like this. You have to select your vehicle type by clicking in the correct circle - these circles are called radio buttons, and you can only have one selected at a time



Entering text

When you want to type information into an online form the first thing you have to do is tell the computer where you want to start typing.

Move your mouse until the arrow on the screen is "in" the box you wish to start typing in. Your arrow will change to an "I beam". It is called this because it looks like a capital I.

When you click in the box a second "I beam" will appear in the box. This "I beam" will be flashing. This means you are ready to start typing. Any keys you press on the keyboard will appear just before this "I beam".

Text box – you have to type in this using the keyboard



Drop down menus

These are used when you are restricted to a specific answer, however there may be many possible answer options. The following example uses the Belfast City Council website to find out a bin collection day. Enter the web address www.belfastcity.gov.uk and select **Bins and recycling**, then scroll down to **Find my bin collection day**

Click the radio button for Postcode, enter your postcode in the text box, and then select Look up address

Enter the full postcode with a space, for example BT1 1GS or BT14 7GP. *

Look up address

A drop down menu will appear. Scroll down to find the right address. When your choice is highlighted in blue, click or tap, and you will navigate to a new web page with the relevant information.
