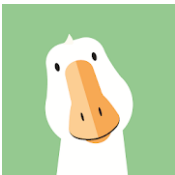
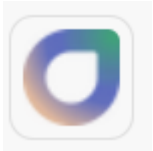


Apps to help the environment

For Food Waste Warriors	
	Olio – ‘Share more, Care more, Waste less’ This app is designed to combat food waste. Connect with your neighbours and local shops so that surplus food and unwanted items can be shared, not thrown away. You can check out a user's profile and star rating before sharing. Android and iOS FREE, with in-app purchases
	Gander This app displays reduced-to-clear food and drink at local supermarkets and convenience stores. Bargains display in real time, so when food is sold it is removed from the list. Available worldwide Android and iOS FREE
	Too Good To Go Another app to combat food waste. It puts you in contact with food producers, including restaurants, bakeries and supermarkets with have leftover food that is time limited. 	Ecosia – For Trees and Privacy Ecosia is a privacy browser app that not only promises to give you a private browsing experience, but also to use profits to plant millions of new trees – so far they have planted 125 million.
