



Listening to radio broadcasts online

Although you can listen to many radio stations on the internet, the best and easiest way to listen to your favourite station is by downloading and installing an app. If you have the app you can save radio broadcasts and podcasts to your device to listen to later when you do not have an internet connection.

The following example is for BBC Sounds.





This app is free to use, however you are required to register and sign in to use this app. You will need an email address. If you already use BBC iPlayer you will already have an account.



The app opens in the Listen Live page




Tap to rewind by 20 seconds

Each circle represents a station. Slide your finger along to select a different station and then tap to listen.
