

What's That Sound?

This fun guessing game will make you laugh out loud!

Use your best vocal chord skills to make the sounds of everyday objects – no words allowed!

Choose sound related team names – the sillier the better.

The Aim Of The Game

One person (the 'sounder'), does their best imitation of a well-known sound, and the other players have to guess what it is before a minute is up.

There are three categories of sounds to choose from:

Household Objects

Transport

Musical Instruments

You Will Need:

- A minute timer - a sand timer or other method.
- Pens and paper to keep score.
- A dice.
- Printed Sound Cards.

How To Play

1. Arrange the cards face down, in their categories.
2. Divide into teams.
3. Throw the dice to see which team goes first, and choose a 'sounder' from that team.
4. Choose a category to play from – a different category for each round.
5. The 'sounder' picks one card from the top of the pile and does not show it to anyone. They must give their best impression of the object using their voice. They can also use actions to help, but no words are allowed!
6. Start the timer! The other players must guess the sound before the time runs out.
7. Game play moves to each team in turn.



Scoring

- Both teams can guess the sound
- The first team to correctly guess the sound gets 1 point.
- The 'sunder' team also gets 1 point if their sound was guessed correctly.
- If no one guesses in time, the game play moves on.

Game Preparation

- Print out and cut the sound cards, 8 cards to each category. Printing on card will work best but paper will do.
- The cards are designed to be printed double sided on card, but if this is not an option, simply print the front side of the cards and write the category on the back of each card in block letters.
