Those eligible for the High Street Scheme should apply online.


Libraries NI expect to see the public making use of our CATs to apply.


Those eligible for the High Street Scheme, should apply online via www.nidirect.gov.uk/spend-local

To start the application you will be asked, as a security measure, to enter your email address



A link will then be sent to your email inbox which will take you straight to the

application form.

- Driving Licence Number
- email will be prepopulated


With the exception of the driving licence number, all of these data fields are mandatory.


Completing the form for yourself or on behalf of someone else:



Select the correct option by selecting 'Apply'.


Enter your National Insurance number

The final step is the Declaration: Read the information and select the box to confirm understanding and finally select Finish
