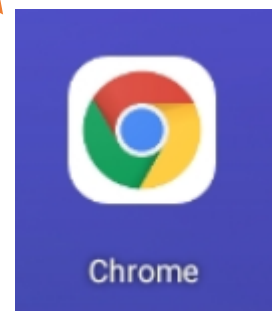


## Searching the internet on your Lenovo

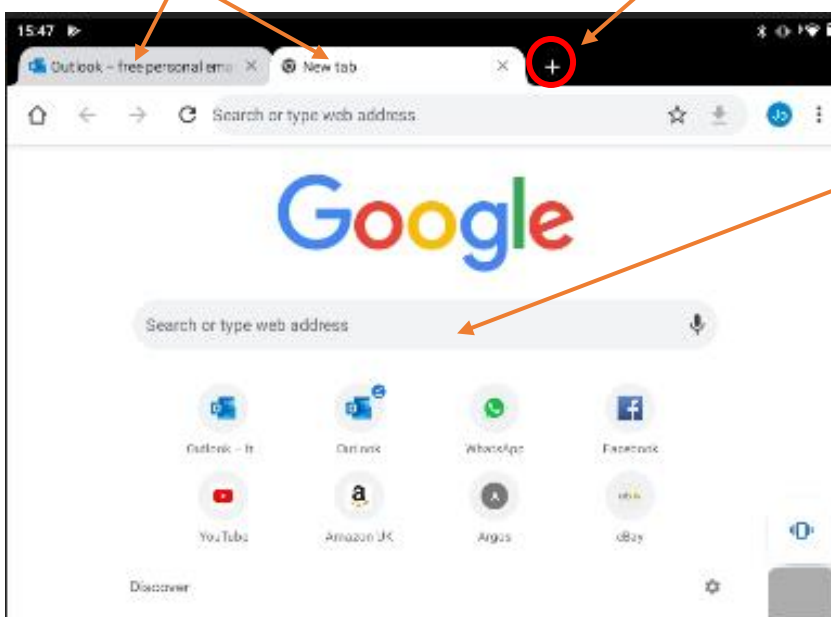


Your Lenovo tablet comes with Chrome preloaded on it. Tapping on the Chrome symbol will take you to an internet search engine. This helps you find websites and information.



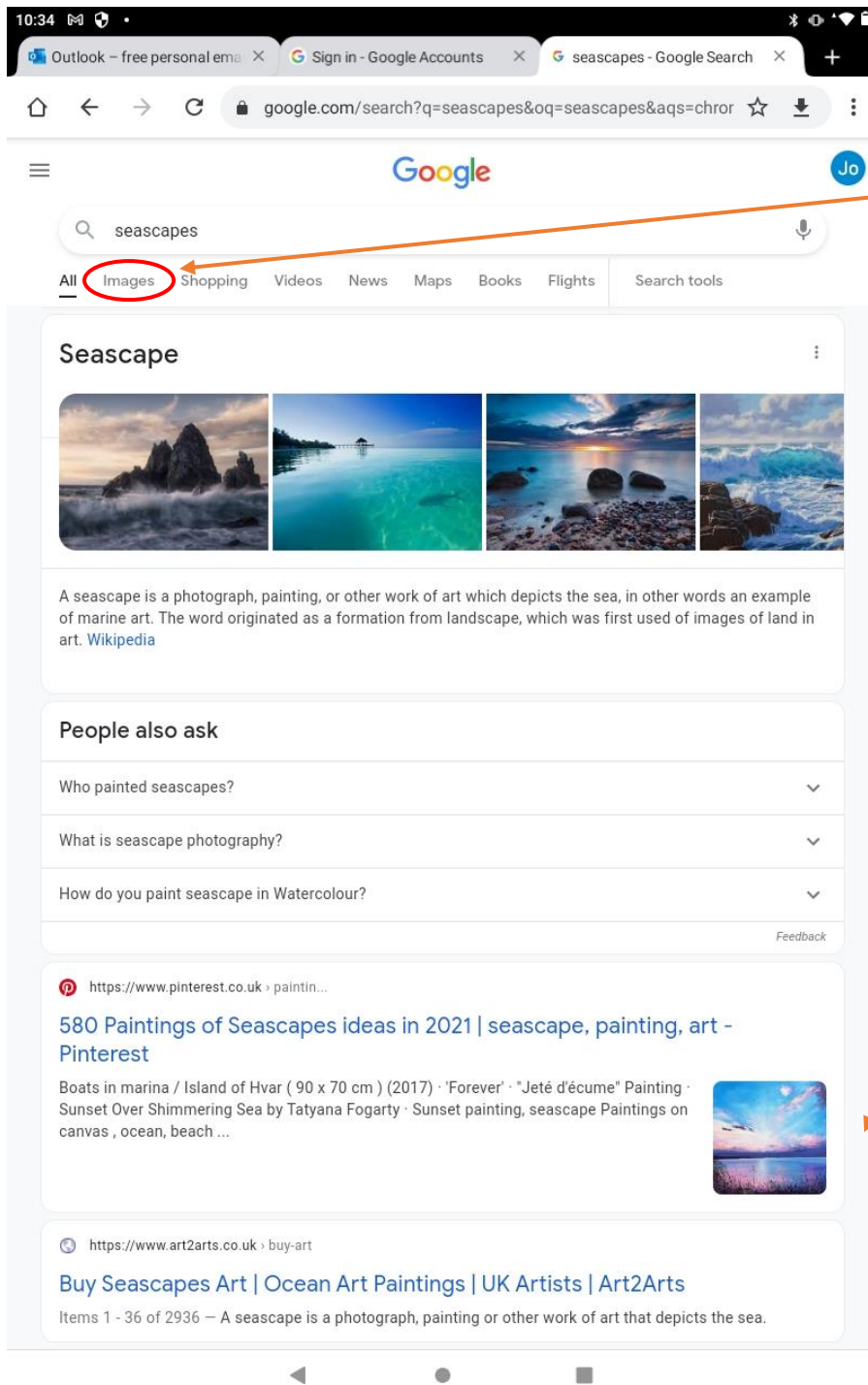
If you have already viewed a website on Chrome it will be open when you first go into Chrome. If you want to open a new page tap on the plus.

These are tabs. Tapping on the tab will take you to the already open website page.



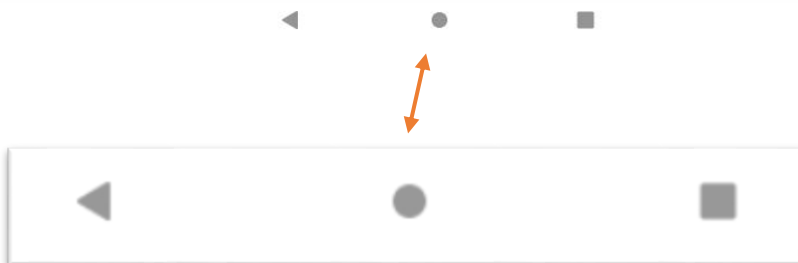
Tap here and a keyboard will appear. Type in the name of a website you want to see or a word relating to the subject you want to know more about.

When you finish typing tap on the arrow on the keyboard.




You can narrow your search results by tapping a topic, for example if you just want pictures tap on **Images**.

This is a list of results. Tap on the result that is of interest to you.

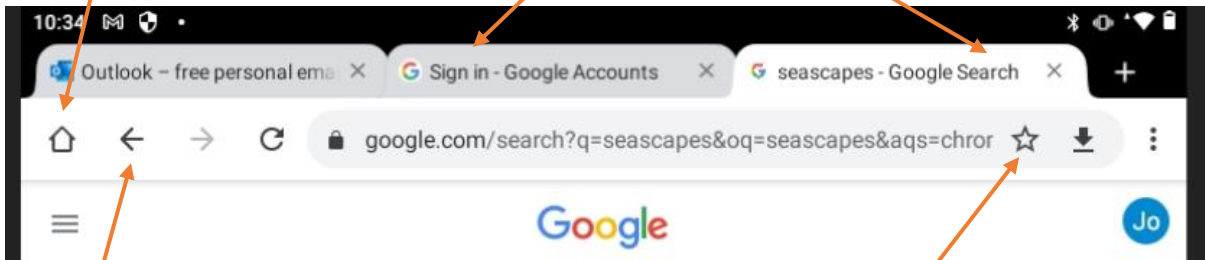



These “buttons” are not part of Chrome (the internet). They are Lenovo “switches”. If you want to leave Chrome, tap on the circle in the middle.

These are tabs, tap on the **X** to close a tab or **+** to open a new tab. You can “jump” between open tabs by tapping in the middle.

“bookmark” it. Tap on the star  to create a bookmark for the website.

To find a website previously bookmarked tap on the 3 dots
