



## **Online Entertainment**

Using your tablet, smartphone or iPad to catch up on the latest films and TV shows is now a growing trend. Some packages are free, some are included with other subscriptions and some are paid either on a monthly or yearly contract. In order to view TV programmes on your device you are required to install the relevant app. In most cases the app is free to download from the App store or the Play store, depending on the type of device you own. All of these apps are very similar and, depending on your subscription, you may be able to download programmes to watch when you are not connected to the internet.

Below is a list of some of the most popular entertainment apps but this is not an exhaustive list.

BBC iPlayer Entertainment ***** 9.51K	Free but you must have a TV license.
ITV Hub: TV Player & Watch series live & on dem **** 345K	Free, although there is a subscription service available if you don't want to put up with the advertisements.
BritBox UK The TV App for British boss	A mix of programmes from the BBC and ITV. No advertisements but there is a charge of £5.99 a month. No contract so you can leave at any time.
All 4 Channel 4's on demand c **** 83.3K	Free, although there is a subscription service available (£3.99 per month) if you don't want to put up with the advertisements. They also have a very good collection of World Drama with Walter Presents
Sky Go Entertainment, Sports & M **** 229K	Available to Sky customers. This will reflect whatever television packages you are currently paying for.  There are similar apps for Virgin TV subscribers
Amazon Prime Video Originals, movies, TV, sports **** 183K	This is a subscription service available to Amazon Prime members. Annual subscription is £79 or £7.99 per month and includes free postage when purchasing some items from Amazon as well as limited use of their music service and some cloud storage.

Netflix Start Watching 全全金金 24.9%	This is a subscription website. The plan costs between £5.99 and £11.99 per month. The higher subscription allows you to watch, in a clearer format, HD or UHD and on more than one device at once. This is useful if there is more than 1 person in the household who wants to watch Netflix.
NOW TV: Movies, TV  Entertainment  ***** 20.48	The Now TV app can be installed on your tablet, iPad or smartphone but you can also buy a device that can be plugged into newer televisions so that you can watch it on the 'big screen'. If buying the "Now TV stick", the price of the stick normally includes a bundle or "Pass" to watch certain programmes for a month or two. After this you pay a subscription which varies in price depending on which "Passes" you subscribe to. You can cancel your subscription at any time. This is a good alternative for people who want to watch Sky television programmes without the yearlong contract.
Disney+ Unlimited entertainment  GET Prop	Recently launched, you can watch programmes by the following franchises - Disney; Pixar; Marvel; Star Wars and National Geographic – for £5.99 per month or £59.99 a year.
YouTube: Watch, List Videon, Music and Live Str ***** 1.73M	Although not strictly a place to watch traditional television programmes you will find lots of fun and instructional videos on YouTube. You may also find clips of films or television programmes that are hard to find. However, not all of these have the television maker's permission and are usually very poor quality and may be suddenly removed from the website.
	YouTube is free of charge but there is a subscription charge available if you do not want to watch the advertisements. Paying a fee also allows you to download and save some of the videos. It is £11.99 per month and includes YouTube music.
