3. Finally use your completed plan to write up your Wild World story. Make sure to include some of your Wild Hero illustrations and try to come up with an exciting title!

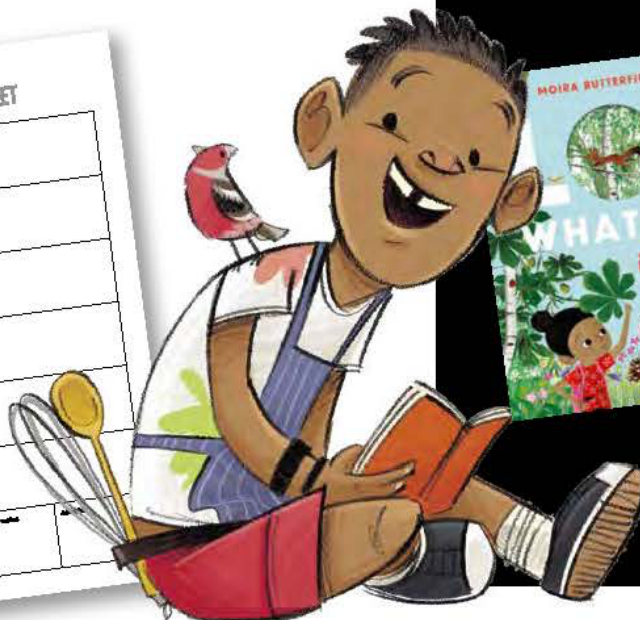
